MARK FLORMAN APPOINTED AS INDEPENDENT INVESTMENT COMMITTEE MEMBER



JOHANNESBURG, SOUTH AFRICA, 01 July 2015 – Mark Florman has been appointed as an independent Investment Committee member of the Pembani Remgro Infrastructure Fund. He has over 34 years of private equity and investment experience.

Mark was the founder of the merchant banking group Maizels Westerberg which specialises in advising on mergers, acquisitions and corporate restructurings. He sold the firm to create Aros Maizels in 2000.

He has held a range of roles during his career including Senior Principal and Managing Director of European private equity firm Doughty Hanson & Co; Chairman of LM Glasfiber, the world's leading supplier of components and services to the wind turbine industry; co-founder of the pan-African private equity firm 8 Miles and CEO of the British Venture Capital Association.

He is Chairman of Time Partners, a consultancy firm to the private equity and venture capital industry advising on capital raising and Private Equity markets; B Corp (UK), a non-profit organisation that provides certification to companies that meet rigorous social and environmental performance, accountability and transparency requirements; and The Centre for Social Justice, an independent think tank seeking to find solutions to poverty in Britain.

Mark was a member of the G8 Social Impact Investment Task Force, was appointed to the Triennial Review of the Big Lottery Fund by the UK Cabinet Office and in March 2015 was appointed to the Board of the BBC Trust and Trustee for England.

He speaks widely on how business impacts society and has developed an Expected Reciprocal Rank ("ERR") metric of social impact measurement.

He is a graduate of the London School of Economics and is married with 3 daughters.
